What should I do in a Medical Emergency?

You must contact CanAssistance toll-free at 1-866-601-2583 or collect at 0-204-775-2583 prior to seeking medical treatment so we can assess your situation, help you locate a suitable provider in your area, and open a medical case to monitor your care. Failure to call before seeking treatment can result in a 30% reduction to your eligible claim payment, or no reimbursement for the expenses you have already incurred. If you are physically unable to call, someone else (family member, friend, hospital, physician's office staff) may call on your behalf. In addition, the medical advisors of Canassistance and the Blue Cross claims administrator must approve all medical procedures (including cardiac procedures, CAT scans and cardiac catheterization) in advance.

In a medical emergency where you are unable to reach CanAssistance, please seek treatment immediately at the nearest health facility, and have a travelling companion or health facility employee contact us on your behalf as soon as possible. When you call, you will be asked to provide general information including your name, group policy number, nature of your emergency, and contact information. Our Assistance Coordinators will monitor your care until treatment is complete.
