Claiming Made Simple

Blackout Period - Claims processing

Claims processing is delayed for new residents during the first 6 weeks of the policy year, while enrolment lists are being finalized. During this time, you're still covered by the Plan and you can submit claims, but reimbursements will only be sent once the Blackout



All opt outs or coverage changes can be completed with the Opt-Out Form, available from your payroll contact. Note that opt outs are permanent, which means that you'll remain opted out for the duration of your time as a resident at McGill.
